DIPLOMA IN PHARMACY

A 2 year full-time Diploma course divided into 2 annual sessions. D. Pharm has been designed to prepare candidates to work as a licensed pharmacist in hospitals, community pharmacies, and other related pharmaceutical fields.

DEGREE IN PHARMACY

A 4 year full-time Degree course divided into 8 semester sessions. B. Pharm has been designed to prepare candidates to work as a Registered pharmacist in hospitals, community pharmacies, Industries, Pharmacovigilance, Regulatory Affairs and other related pharmaceutical fields.

Eligibility criteria for D. Pharmacy

FIRST YEAR DIPLOMA IN PHARMACY (D. PHARM)

The nationality of candidate should be INDIAN. Candidate should have passed the HSC examination (Science Stream) with Physics & Chemistry as compulsory subjects along with one of the subjects Mathematics or Biology (Botany & Zoology).

Eligibility criteria for B. Pharmacy

- The candidate should be an Indian National.
- Passed HSC or its equivalent examination with Physics and Chemistry as compulsory Subjects along with one of the Mathematics or Biology
- Obtained at least 45% marks for open category
- At least 40% marks in case of candidates of Backward class Categories and Persons with Disability belonging only to Maharashtra State) in the above subjects taken together.
- The candidate should have appeared in all the subjects in MHT-CET and obtain non zero score in MHT-CET.
- Should obtain non zero positive score in NEET or the candidate should have appeared in all the subjects in MHT-CET and obtain non zero score in MHTCET.

Eligibility criteria for M. Pharmacy

- Students who have passed B. Pharmacy from any AICTE & PCI approved institute only are eligible to take for admission to M. Pharm.
- They must have obtained at least with 50% of marks for Open category & 45% of marks for other backward category & none zero score in GPAT.
- Any other criterion declared by appropriate authority from time to time

ADMISSION PROCEDURE

FIRST YEAR DEGREE IN PHARMACY (B. PHARM)

- 80% of the seats are filled through Centralized Admission Procedure (CAP) conducted by Directorate of Technical Education, Maharashtra State, Mumbai & State CET cell, Maharashtra State.
- 20% of the seats are filled as Institute Level Quota by the college according to merit & as per guidelines of the Directorate of Technical Education, Maharashtra State, Mumbai & State CET cell, Maharashtra State.

DEPARTMENTS

PHARMACEUTICS

Pharmaceutics is one of the Important subjects of B.Pharmacy course. Students learn and gather knowledge about formulations, dosage forms and their evaluation. The laboratory is equipped with quality instruments require for practicals as recommended by PCI syllabus.



PHARMACEUTICAL CHEMISTRY



B. Pharmacy students will learn the basic synthetic procedures, evaluation of drug formulations as per pharmacopoeia standards, isolation, identification of synthetic and natural compounds. Student will learn to handle different chemicals and their precautionary measures. Laboratory is equipped with quality instruments to fulfill the basic practical requirements and also the safety measures.

PHARMACOLOGY

The practical associated with the subject Pharmacology, are conducted in this laboratory which gives knowledge about structural organisation & function of living organs and cells. The effect of drugs in animals is also studied in this laboratory. The laboratory is structured with basic instruments required for pharmacology practical as per prescribed syllabus.



PHARMACOGNOSY



The laboratory is used for microscopical, macroscopical, physicochemical, phytochemical evaluation of medicinal plants. The laboratory will also deal with identification, extraction, isolation and purification of phytoconstituents. The laboratory is equipped with instruments required for basic practical trainings as per the PCI syllabus.

MACHINE ROOM

Machine-pilot plant facility is equipped with a station rotary tablet punching machine, Tablet coating machine, Capsule filling machine, and Ointment filling machine.



INSTRUMENTATION ROOM



Central instrumentation facilities are available with sophisticated instruments such as Systronic HPLC138, Shimadzu UV-1800 Flame photometer Systronic 130, Sonicator Dolphin, Conductivity apparatus, Photoflurometer 152 Systronic, Calorimeter Delphine DP 1080, PH meter.
