

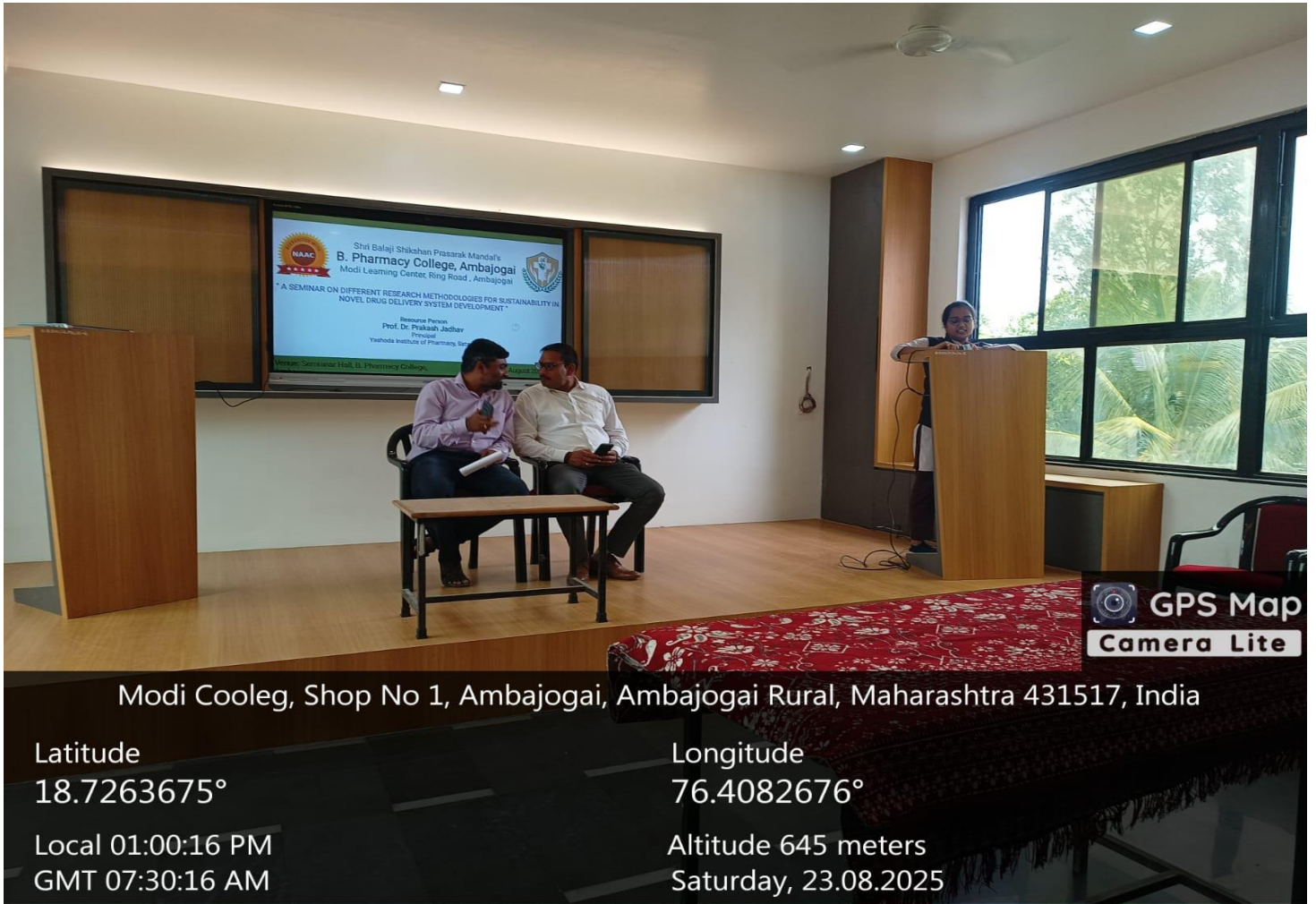
Description

Adv. Mr. Ajit Lomte stressed the urgent need for pharmacists to strictly follow dispensing laws to prevent the misuse and abuse of controlled substances. He highlighted that pharmacists are often the first line of defense in ensuring that prescription drugs are not diverted for illegal use. He also advocated for stronger government policies against illegal drug trafficking and the over prescribing of medications, pointing out that stricter legal frameworks and enforcement can significantly reduce the risk of drug abuse. Furthermore, Mr. Lomte discussed the legal consequences and punishments associated with drug misuse, including imprisonment, fines, cancellation of licenses, and long-term criminal records. He explained how violations of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances (NDPS) Act carry severe penalties and how both users and facilitators of drug misuse can face strict legal action. His address served as a powerful reminder of the legal responsibilities tied to pharmaceutical practice.



Principal Dr. Tarke S.R. highlighted the important role of pharmacists in fighting drug abuse through patient education, proper medicine dispensing, and support for public health efforts. The seminar ended with an interactive session that encouraged participants to follow professional standards and help protect public health.

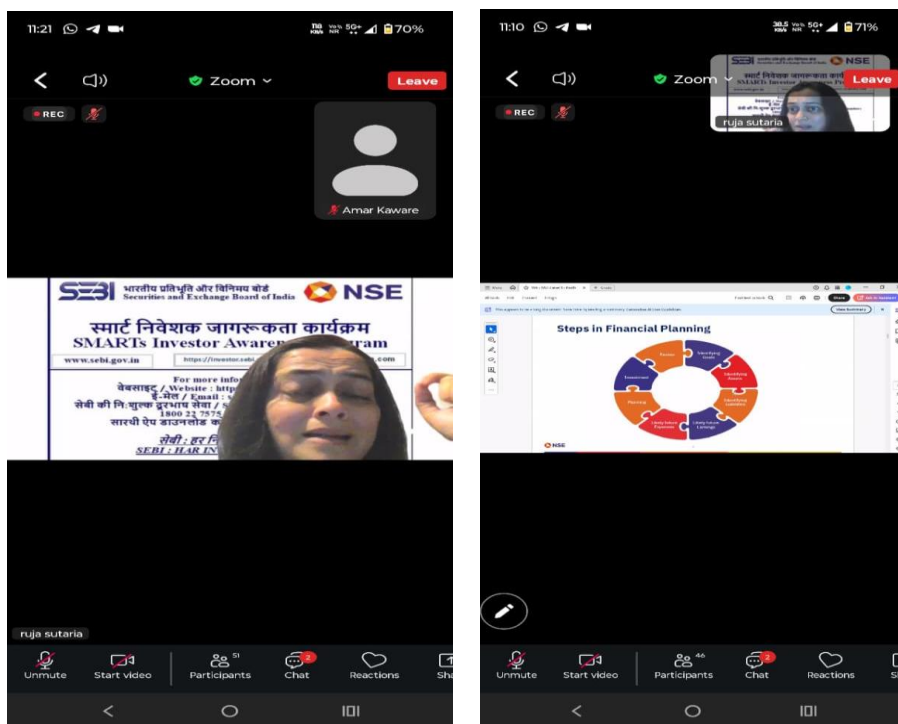

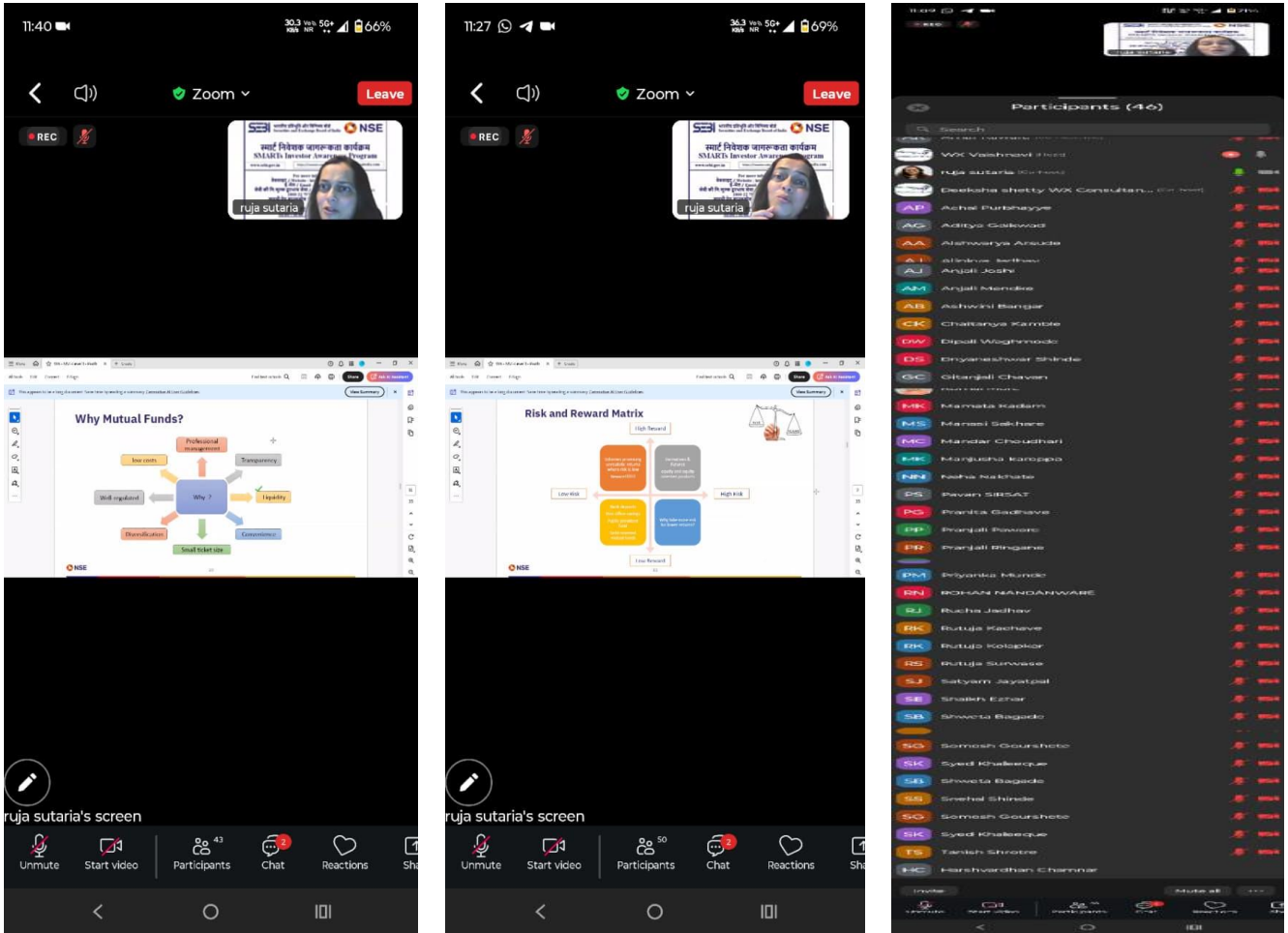
Description
